## NIGHT TOURS

### 1856 – The Untold Story

**Tuesday & Saturday**

On the 8th of June 1856 a total of 194 people, descendants from the Bounty, arrived on Norfolk Island from Pitcairn Island aboard the Morayshire. This tour brings the past to life with audio aboard the coach recounting stories told by today's descendants. Hear old recordings in the Norfolk language and songs as you drive past the relevant homes and buildings. This one hour tour is very evocative and brings to life the arrival of the Pitcairn Islanders, their feelings and stories. This is the Untold Story.

### Lantern Lit Ghost Tour

**Wednesday & Saturday**

Something is out there. As the night sets in and the long shadows fall, take a lantern-lit ride to the other side. Step through the veil into the worst of all possible worlds. Explore the crooked, cobbled netherworld of Norfolk's dark and troubled past visiting real haunted sites. Hear ghost stories which have for generations lain forgotten and abandoned until now. Double dare you to follow...

### Sound & Light Show

**Tuesday & Saturday**

Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. The stillness and the stars are just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788. However, with the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as you are taken through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

### Wonderland by Night

Among 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland lit up like an enchanted forest, meander along (or ride in the 'moon buggy') a gentle winding path with Archie, a descendant of the Bounty mutineers, as he recites his poems and lights up the dioramas.
