



DAY TOURS

Half Day Apia Township & Surrounds

Monday to Saturday - 9.30am

See some of Apia's main landmarks including Mulinu'u Peninsula, Parliament House & The Independence Monument. A stop at the Samoan Catholic Cathedral displays the fine artistry & skills of the Samoan craftsmen who built the church & crafted the beautiful carvings & artwork. Enjoy a visit to the markets & Robert Louis Stevenson's former home 'Vailima' which is now a museum set in magnificent gardens & artefacts from the period when he was residing in Samoa.

Half Day Falefa Falls & Piula Cave Pool

Monday to Saturday - 9.30am

Enjoy the scenic drive along the North East coast of Upolu Island passing through local villages before stopping at the beautiful Falefa Falls which is 30ft high & drops directly into the ocean. Time for a refreshing swim at the Piula Fresh Water Cave Pool which runs alongside the ocean & underneath the oldest Methodist church in Samoa.

Half Day Samoan Traditional Cultural Show & Market

Tuesday to Friday - 10.30am

Located in the heart of Apia, the Samoan Cultural Village showcases age-old culture & traditions in a fun & interactive way. The show starts with a welcoming Kava Ceremony followed by demonstrations including weaving, Umu cooking, carving & tattooing. Enjoy the Umu lunch with Samoan entertainment before heading to the markets for some local produce & handicrafts.

Full Day Essence of Upolu

Monday to Saturday - 9.30am

Start your day with a beautiful scenic drive along the North Eastern coast stopping at Falefa Village & the Cathedral. Drive through Le Mafa Pass (1700ft above sea level) with breathtaking views of the northern shorelines, lush green forests, plantations & traditional Samoan villages. Stop off at Sopoaga Botanical Gardens & waterfalls where you can see a coconut husking demonstration. Next stop is To Sua Ocean Trench at Lotofaga Village. To Sua translates to 'Big Hole' & is a natural deep swimming hole surrounded by lush tropical foliage. Travel on to the pristine white sand Lalomanu Beach where you will have time to snorkel & swim or relax in one of the colourful beach faleas. Enjoy a BBQ lunch before returning to Apia.

Full Day Tafatafa Beach & South East Upolu

Monday to Saturday - 9.30am

Depart Apia via the main Cross Island Road & visit the Robert Louis Stevenson Museum for a tour of this majestic site steeped in history & surrounded by beautiful gardens with fabulous views of the mountains. Stop at the Papapapaitai Falls & drive through villages & plantations to Tafatafa Beach where you can enjoy a swim in the sparkling blue waters or relax on the white sands. After a tasty BBQ lunch, see how fresh coconut cream is made. Head back to Apia through the Le Mafa Pass (1700ft above sea level) for a spectacular drive with breathtaking views of the east & south shorelines.

Full Day Savaia Clam Reserve & Vailima Botanical Gardens

Monday to Saturday - 9.30am

Head south to the first stop at Savaia Clam Reserve. Pass through local villages, colourful gardens, plantations & majestic mountains. The reserve is inside a roped & buoyed area 75 metres from the beach. Snorkel the waters to see the colourful giant clams, fish & maybe even a turtle. Enjoy lunch before heading to Vailima Botanical Gardens to finish the day.

Full Day Savai'i Northern Coast

Monday to Saturday - 8am

Head off aboard *Lady Samoa III* ferry on the 8am ferry to Savai'i. Sit back & relax on the 1 ¼ hour journey across to Salelologa Wharf. Visit the local markets & move onto Sapapalii Village the landing place of the early missionaries. Visit Saleaula Village where local families still live amongst the lava fields created from the 1905 Mt Matavanu eruptions. See ruins of the village church & the incredible site of the Virgin's Grave. Visit Satoalepai Wetland where you can view the turtles while enjoying your lunch. Head back in time to board the 2pm ferry back to Upolu.

Full Day Savai'i Southern Coast

Monday to Saturday - 8am

Board *Lady Samoa III* ferry for a 1 ¼ hour journey to Salelologa Wharf in Savai'i. Visit the local markets before heading down the stunning south coast through several small coastal villages & a lush rainforest area. One of the highlights is the Alofaaga Blowholes which are impressive in sight & force. Natural tubes of lava rock meet the ocean allowing for ocean swells to shoot water in jet streams as high as 30 metres into the air - truly spectacular! Enjoy a Siapo demonstration with a group of local Samoan women who will show how they collect the raw product from the surrounding environment, how it is processed & then made into the final piece of fine artwork. Head back to the wharf via Afu Aau Falls for a refreshing swim & lunch.
